## **PARTICIPATING PROFESSOR**

## A participating member of the COB faculty:

- 1. Teaches at least 3 credits or holds a full-time administrative appointment, and
- 2. Actively engages in the school's life through activities beyond direct teaching responsibilities.

**Full-time** professors will participate in **two or more** of the following non-teaching activities; **part-time** professors will participate in at least one:

- 1. Serves the institution through different committees, such as:
  - a. Curriculum
  - b. Library
  - c. Personnel
  - d. Accreditation
  - e. Assessment of student learning
  - f. Other
- 2. Participates in institutional governance at the three levels (School, Campus, and UPR System)
- 3. Serves in the community or professional organizations representing the Institution:
  - a. Advisory boards
  - b. Academic and Professional associations
  - c. Governmental organizations
  - d. ONGs
  - e. Other
- 4. Engages in the assurance of learning activities.
- 5. Participate in three or more faculty development activities. The activities counted must not be related to those endeavors required or inherent to the professors.
- 6. Engages in research activities sponsored by the institution (i.e. FIPI, PII, IINAS, external funds)
- 7. Represents the school at university activities such as commencement and alumni relations events.
- 8. Other activities that support the institutional goals of the school's mission.

Participating faculty members are expected to deliver at least 60% of the teaching within each discipline and constitute at least 75% of the faculty at the college level.

## **SUPPORTING PROFESSOR**

A supporting faculty member **only** engages in direct teaching activities: preparing, teaching, grading, and holding office hours.
